

How to Print These Cards and Use These Cards

Download this document to your computer and save it for future reference. When you are ready to print one or more of these cards for use, choose File, then Print. Once this entire document loads in your Printer queue, choose the specific Single Page you want to print so that you save paper and ink. And, of course, you can select Black & White if you don't want the card to print in color.

Once your specific card has printed, fold it in half like you would find when you purchase store-bought cards. If necessary, trim away the extra paper edge using scissors or a paper cutter.

Last, write your sentiments on the inside of the card for your special graduate and either include your monetary gift or attach it to your gift-wrapped gift.

NOTE: each card includes a larger photo on a separate page that you can print and use as decorations for your home. Use them to hang on the wall, the refrigerator, taped as "paper" on a wrapped gift, and more!














































Print this and fold in half at the photo's edge. Then trim away the excess paper making the edges rounded.
