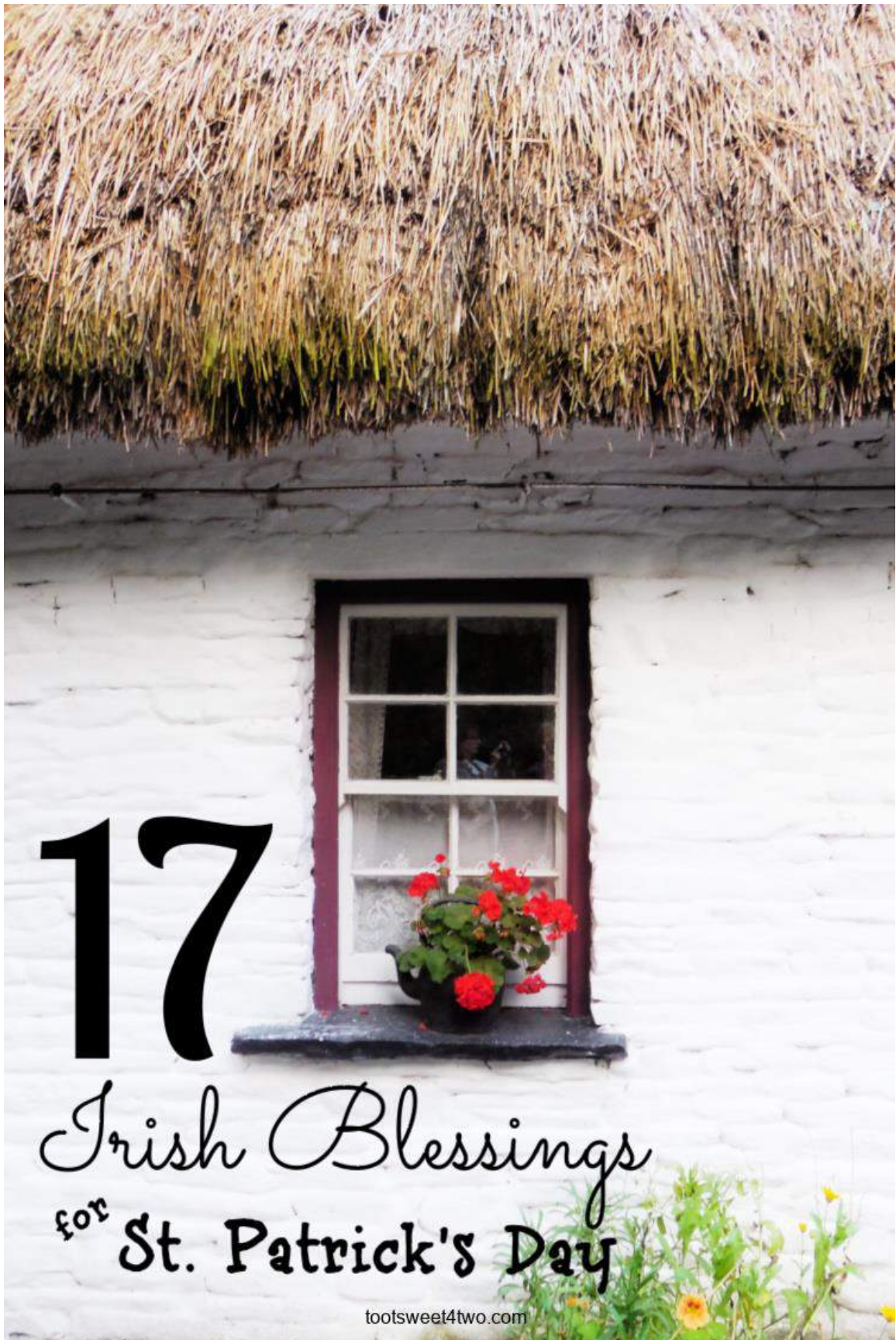
How to Print and Use These Designs
